Metaphysical poetry is also distinguishable for its dramatic beginning in many cases. Donne's "The Sun Rising" begins with the line "Busy old fool unsuly Sun". The metaphysical poets have been also blamed for 'Obscurity' in their poems. But this is to be considered that in their effort to find the verbal equivalent for states of mind they made themselves difficult to understand. ~~But~~<sup>4/6</sup> Metaphysical poets can not <sup>necessarily</sup> be blamed for the obscurity as reason may be ascribed to an obstacle at the level of reader as well.

Metaphysical poetry revolves itself into the two broad divisions of amorous and religious verses. John Donne, the initiator of this school of poetry excelled in both the kinds of verse.
